Portland Red Triangle Cricket Club will operate a Child Protection Policy as defined by the ECB.

The club will follow the guidelines laid down in the information pack "Developing Your Club" and the Child Protection book titled "Awareness and Procedures for All Adults Involved in Cricket for Children and Young People."

Portland Red Triangle C C are not responsible for determining whether or not Child Abuse has taken place, but they are responsible for protecting the children.

Procedures

- Ensure all staff complies with an agreed code of conduct and practice.
- All volunteers will follow the code of conduct for club officials and volunteers.
- P.R.T. CC adopts an open door policy.
- Arrange to meet children with parents present.
- Encouraging parents and other coaches to attend training and support competitions.
- Encourage parents to take greater responsibility for ensuring their Child's safety.

Any reports of child abuse to be reported to the Club's Welfare Officer who will consider the appropriate course of action.

After this point the club may refer the matter to the County Welfare Officer, Social Services, NSPCC or the Police.
